Mr. Patton said this is a request that the county fiscal officer send us the first half of the 2016 property tax revenues as they are collected and starting in January as opposed to waiting until the scheduled settlement day, which is usually in May at least for the first half. This ordinance will continue through the second half of 2016 as far as the collection and distribution of property tax revenues.
