Discussion about the steps to the Village Columbarium. Asked that CT come up with potential drawings accommodating ADA requirements and see how the distance from the road factors into the final design. This work will be completed this year.

Discussion about the upcoming campaign to raise money to provide flag holders for veteran's graves. We need approximately 535 markers. We will also need a few extras for Rob Arnold to have when the need arises for a new burial. This will be a joint effort with The Historical Society, and the Village.

We re-capped the Memorial Day ceremony. It was a wonderful program, with a few suggested adjustments for next year:

- The Fire Department color guard would be a good choice going forward.
- Need to print agenda for participants to know the final order of events.
- Sound system needs improvement, so that those standing off to the sides can hear clearly as well.

John Brockway stated that Bartlett has been hired to assess the tree canopy in the Cemetery so that more maintenance of trees can be done rather than just cutting them down. We look forward to that report.

It was brought to our attention that the proposed opening of the stream will significantly impact the size of crane that can come into the cemetery.
