The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Mr. Larry Trace.

Designs were presented for the veterans' memorial stone that has been ordered by the Administration. This stone is to replace the current stone on the south side of the main entrance to the cemetery. It will be the same size and material as the existing stone but include more names and conflicts.

Moved by White, seconded by Carr to approve the shape and placement of the new stone, with further discussion on the layout of the lists on the stone. Vote was unanimous.

HVAC and electrical have been installed at the old bank building. Walkway and landscaping to occur next year. There is no plan for a bathroom in the building, people will continue to use the porta-potty. The Commission is to be consulted on the interior build-out of the building.

Village workers are pouring footers and top dressing and seeding the spots where trees have been removed.

No plan to expand the cemetery into owned land due to Greenbriar flooding concerns. This continues to be a spot of contention because the topography would not be changing to accommodate decades of need for the Village.


The new columbarium for Fireman's circle will be delivered in September, along with the benches for the most recent one.

Chairman Trace voiced concerns over the out-sourced mowing being too low, too expensive, and requested that facilities Commission revisit bringing the mowing back in house.

Seven people are on the waiting list for pre-need graves. They will not be available this year.

The new Cemetery software is still updating and not ready to go yet.
