Dear Mr. Woofter,

The East Washington Street Improvement Project is well underway and progressing according to schedule at this time. As we look towards the coming school year, I would like to provide you with information on how the project will progress and the safety measures that will be in place for both motorists and pedestrians impacting travel to the schools in the Village.

**ROAD CLOSURES ON EAST WASHINGTON STREET:**

This project is broken up into four road closure sections by estimated date. When each section is closed, only eastbound local traffic will be allowed to enter the work zone area. Below is the schedule for the road closures on East Washington Street:

- July 6 through August 28 -- Cleveland Street to Ridgewood Road
- August 17 through September 7 -- Ridgewood Road to Billy Campbell Boulevard
- September 3 through October 16 -- Philomethian Street to Cleveland Street
- October 19 through November 20 -- North Main Street to Philomethian Street

\*This schedule is subject to change due to weather or project variables.

**DETOUR ROUTE:**

Traffic is detoured via BELL STREET during road closure periods. Signage is posted for the detour route.

**PEDESTRIAN ACCESS IN THE CLOSED SECTIONS OF THE PROJECT:**

During each closed section of the project, pedestrian access on the sidewalks will be maintained on one side of the street only, with the opposite side closed as a work area. Signage will be posted as to which sidewalk is open to use. The project manager and the contractor have been advised school children will be navigating through the work zone area on the sidewalk.

**FINAL STREET PAVING:**

In the final phase of the project starting in November, the street repaving work will begin and take place in the entire stretch of roadway. The roadway and sidewalks will remain open during this phase, with expected delays with moving work zones and crews as the paving is completed.

In closing, the Village of Chagrin Falls will work closely with the Chagrin Falls Exempted Village Schools to monitor the traffic flow situation as school opens and through the end of the project period. We would like to thank all motorists and pedestrians for their patience as we work diligently to complete this important project in a safe and timely manner.
