## CURRENT ELIGIBILITY

### PHASE 1C – 246,000 Ohioans

[ Conditions ]

- Type 1 diabetes
- Pregnant
- Bone marrow recipients
- ALS

[ Profession ]

- Childcare services
- Funeral services
- Law enforcement and corrections officers

### PHASE 2A – 695,000 Ohioans

[ Conditions ]

- Age 60+

### PHASE 1D – 197,000 Ohioans

[ Conditions – under 50 and ]

- Type 2 diabetes
- End-stage renal disease

### PHASE 2B – 1,200,000 Ohioans

[ Conditions ]

- Age 50+

### PREVIOUSLY ELIGIBLE

[ Conditions ]

- Age 65+
- K-12 school employees on-site
- Severe congenital, developmental or early-onset medical disorders

New phases equal an additional 2,338,000 people newly eligible. **Vaccination allocations received will not cover all people immediately.** Vaccine appointments will be scheduled as quickly as possible given the amount available. Expect a delay after pre-registration and appointment confirmation.
