*Note:*

*Before any assignment is made, if the individual is a legal heir, the Village demands some sort of proof, which is usually an order of the respective probate court, indicating that the interest of the grave has been transferred to the listed heirs. This order should be certified by the probate court as being authentic. Sometimes the order is known as a "Certificate of Transfer". Other times, the order may be entitled, "Judgment Entry of Release of Assets Without Administration".*

*In any event, the probate court order should accompany the application and affidavit.*
