MAUSOLEUMS: DRAFT RULES 3/7/2019

1. Mausoleums are allowed in Evergreen Hill Cemetery only in specifically designated lots. Mausoleum lots are a minimum size of 20' x 20'.
2. The cost of a mausoleum lot is \$30,000 for a resident, and \$60,000 for a non-resident. No Village resident may purchase a mausoleum lot for a non-resident. This cost includes the concrete foundation that will be provided by the Village.
3. All sales are final upon installation of the mausoleum. The Village (only) may repurchase an unused mausoleum lot for 75% of the current sale price, at the discretion of the Cemetery Commission.
4. Detailed plans and drawings for any proposed mausoleum must be submitted and approved by the Cemetery Sexton prior to installation. Plans are to include a diagram of the proposed mausoleum showing all sides of the mausoleum, dimensions, materials, and an exact rendition of the wording and/or picture to be installed on it.
5. All mausoleums shall be manufactured in the United States by a monument company approved by the Village of Chagrin Falls. Stainless steel pins are required wherever pins are to be installed.
6. The monument company is responsible to accept, inspect, and arrange to set the mausoleum, as well as for any costs associated with the installation crane, any property damage that may result, and any traffic control that may be required.
7. Prior to mausoleum installation, the Cemetery Sexton will inspect the mausoleum to ensure that it meets all requirements and is the same as the approved plans. The Village of Chagrin Falls is not responsible for any damage prior to installation.
8. All caskets to be buried in mausoleum crypts shall be approved for this application.
