Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chariman Larry Trace.

Cemetery Expansion

The expansion was discussed and the map was reviewed. It was agreed that with only 15 niches remaining in the current columbarium the construction of a new outdoor columbarium would be a priority, as that is the only option available to non-residents. The historic columbarium will be available to residents. Due to the lag time between preparing in-ground gravesites and beign able to use them, it was agreed that the work to be done on that project should be included the 2020 Capital Budget. Presently there are only 70 full size in-ground graves sites available to sell..

Ohio S&L Building

The commission agreed that the donated building would be a desireable addition to the cemetery and that there was a need for a more appopriate office and meeting space. They feel the property owner should bear some of the costs of moving the structure, which are still being ascertained, as he is benefitting from the move which will allow him to construct a new home on the lot, and will also receive a tax deduction for the donation.
