The meeting was called to order, at Evergreen Hill Cemetery, at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Larry Trace.

Van Curen has been given the contract to do the massive tree trimming and cleanup work in the cemetery. This will most likely be done in the fall. Many of the trees, especially the oaks, will face disease risk if trimmed before fall. Many of the dead branches that are partially fallen need to be removed as well.

Flag pole for Fireman's Circle has been ordered and paid for by Larry Trace.

The administration has decided to consider bluestone instead of pavers/bricks for around the columbarium in Fireman's Circle, they are pricing it.

Administration has decided to move the maintenance garage to create more graves instead of following the expansion plan. The new maintenance garage will have to have a wing attached to it where Rob Arnold can meet with families, complete with A/C, heat, and a flat screen. It seems we are not getting the Savings and Loan Building.

Village is going to run the electrical service to the Village Mausoleum. Materials have been ordered. \$30,000 has been allocated to do electrical, support the floor, and replace the roof with a new slate roof.

Rob and John are going to cemetery conference in Columbus, August 2, 3, & 4. They will bring back more product to fight the mold on headstones.
