

**VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS
CEMETERY COMMISSION
September 14, 2021**

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Larry Trace at Evergreen Hill Cemetery.

Rob Schwind brought pictures of the headstones damaged by landscapers. He insists that ten stones in any direction you can find landscaper damages stones and Veteran's Markers too.

Two weeks until tree removal will start, then tree trimming will be done after that.

Rob Arnold and John Famageltto attended the Conference in August and found a second company to bid on the build out of the Village Mausoleum. He also found many new cemetery data base management possibilities. Need to be careful because many use GPS now, and that isn't particularly accurate. Also, the trees make it difficult as well.

The Commission voted to buy back one grave from Pamela Yaecker.

Electricity has been run to the Village Mausoleum. CT to see if structural foam will be strong enough to support the floor and fill the voids. The Mausoleum is to have a slate roof, but we need quotes for budget.

Blue stone will be installed at Fireman's Circle around the existing Columbarium. Flag pole is off center by 15 feet. John Brockway wishes it to remain that way.

We are going to investigate getting stones for Veteran's graves that don't have any.

Rob Arnold sprayed the Civil War Monument and a couple of other stones to ward off mold/algae growth.

Cemetery expansion to be discussed in January.
