The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Chairman Angie DeBernardo.

TEMPORARY DISPLAY GUIDELINES FOR PUBLIC PARKS

There was discussion regarding holiday decorations in the parks and what areas in the parks that can be designated for decorations. Specific guidelines and restrictions were reviewed and discussed.

Moved by Mrs. DeBernardo, seconded by Ms. Rogoff that we adopt the three maps of the three downtown parks, Riverside Park, Bell Street Park, and Triangle Park with the caveat that the Riverside Park will now be amended to place a red "X" on R4, R6, and R8 so that those are not available for decorations and that these will be used to determine where people can apply for temporary displays during the months of November, December, and January, as per our regulation. Carried. Ayes: DeBernardo, Grube, Rogoff. Nays: None.

Moved by Mrs. DeBernardo, seconded by Ms. Rogoff that we restrict signs accompanied with temporary displays in the Winter months, no larger than 8 ½" X 11", the top of the sign can be no higher than 2 feet off the ground, there can be no more than one sign per application, and these restrictions only apply to temporary displays between the time period of November 1st and January 15th. Carried. Ayes: DeBernardo, Grube, Rogoff. Nays: None.

Moved by Mrs. DeBernardo, seconded by Ms. Rogoff that these temporary display restrictions apply to the period of time between November 1st and January 15th. Carried. Ayes: DeBernardo, Grube, Rogoff. Nays: None.

This will go to the administration to develop an application and the law director to develop legislation.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-17

The proposed ordinance to authorize the Mayor to execute a document amending a lease between the Village of Chagrin Falls and SWC BAN Case Holdings, LLC for property known as Parcel Number 931-13-058, and declaring an emergency was reviewed and discussed.

Moved by Mrs. DeBernardo, seconded by Mrs. Grube that we recommend this lease agreement for adoption to Council. Carried. Ayes: DeBernardo, Grube, Rogoff. Nays: None.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-18

The proposed ordinance to authorize the Mayor to enter into a license agreement with the Chagrin Athletic Association for use of the River Run Park and Founders Field for sports events, and declaring an emergency was reviewed and discussed.

Moved by Mrs. DeBernardo, seconded by Mrs. Grube to recommend that this contract be adopted by Council. Carried. Ayes: DeBernardo, Grube, Rogoff. Nays: None.
