River Run Park:

- Playground has been weeded by the Service Dept. Trees, shrubs, etc. (21) have been marked for moving away from Bocce ball court and other areas; will be replanted by Chagrin River Watershed Partners and Davey Tree.
- Dog run (Solon Road gate) has been locked. Upgrades on the 2021 budget include expansion, new fence, and new ground cover (to be determined).

Riverside Park:

- Destruction to the skating shelter pavilion, picnic tables and major littering continues; neighbors clean up daily. Determined this is a CFPD, not Parks, matter which has been brought to the attention of Chief Amber Dacek.
- StoryWalk has been a success. Another laminated StoryWalk book will be mounted in merchant windows in town this week.
- Chamber of Commerce "Ghost Walk" benefit for the Chagrin Falls Historical Society: All went well.
- Barre 3 classes: Winding down given the colder weather.
- Encore Chamber Concert "Gather Around Music: Well-received! At least 80-100 people attended and respected social distancing requirements.
