SOUTH MAIN STREET - TRUCK TRAFFIC AND EXCESSIVE SPEED

South Main Street residents complained about vehicles speeding on South Main Street and truck traffic on South Main Street. Chief Dacek assured them that they have been monitoring this area but they have not issued a lot of tickets. When the officers are there drivers slow down and that is the point. The problem that they run into with regulating truck traffic is that trucks are allowed to come into town if they have a purpose. There are routes that are recommended for them and there are streets that are “no through trucks”. A through truck is one that doesn’t have a destination, they are cutting through, so then you have to be able to show that that is in fact what they are doing. She said they will put the speed sign out in the Spring.

CROSSWALK SAFETY

There was discussion regarding pedestrian safety in the crosswalks in the downtown area. Suggestions were to add enforcement, paint the crosswalks, additional lights/flashers, and possibly bollards.
