VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS
EAST WASHINGTON STREET IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

June 5, 2020

The Village of Chagrin Falls will be starting the East Washington Street infrastructure improvement project on **Monday, June 15, 2020**. This project includes sanitary sewer rehabilitation, abandonment of a redundant watermain, and pavement resurfacing. The existing sanitary sewer line is 112 years old, and the pavement is over 15 years old, both past their service life. This project starts at North Main Street and extends east to Billy Campbell Boulevard.

Initially, there will be sanitary sewer lining work performed in the entire project area, which will result in minor traffic disruptions, but all traffic will remain open.

Starting approximately on Monday, July 6, 2020, major work resulting in full road closures will commence and will be split into four separate blocks. Full closure will only occur at one block at a time, and accommodations will be made to allow access for property owners in each closed block. The full road closure schedule is as follows:

- BLOCK A – North Main Street to Philomethian Street
October 19 through November 20
- BLOCK B – Philometian Street to Cleveland Street
September 3 through October 16
- BLOCK C – Cleveland Street to Ridgewood Road
July 6 through August 14
- BLOCK D – Ridgewood Road to Billy Campbell Boulevard
August 12 through September 7

Traffic will be detoured to BELL STREET for the full road closure periods. Signage will be posted for the detour route. This schedule is approximate and subject to change due to weather and project variables. Village staff, our engineer, and the contractors on the project will work to minimize disruption and inconvenience during this major project.

This project is scheduled to reach completion around December 1, 2020. Further information will be posted when announced throughout the duration of the project. This project is funded by low-interest loans from the Ohio EPA and a grant from the Ohio Public Works Commission.
