

**ORDINANCE 2021-14

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXTEND THE
CONTRACT WITH EDC CORPORATION FOR A PARKING
CITATION AND ENFORCEMENT MANAGEMENT
SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2017-48 was adopted on August 14, 2017 authorizing the Mayor to enter into a contract with EDC Corporation (“EDC”) for a Parking Citation and Enforcement Management System;

WHEREAS, in Section 1 of Ordinance 2017-48 the Village retained the right to extend the contract with EDC Corporation (“EDC”) for an additional four (4) years beyond the initial three (3) year term;

WHEREAS, EDC has proposed a new schedule of payments for years 4 through 7 which are acceptable to the Village and its Police Department.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to extend the contract with EDC for the Parking Citation and Enforcement Management System for an additional four (4) years at the rate of Twenty-Seven Thousand Twenty-Five Dollars (\$27,025.00) per year in years 4 through 6 commencing February of 2021 and ending in January of 2024, and to pay the sum of Twenty Eight Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Six Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$28,376.25) to maintain the contract with EDC in year 7 commencing in February 2024 and ending in January 2025.

Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract extension authorized in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

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Section 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

Section 5. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance is necessary to take immediate effect since the initial three (3) year term of the contract expires in February of 2021 and the Village has determined that maintaining this contract in place will reduce costs to the Village, and improve parking availability and parking citation enforcement within the Village; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
