**A RESOLUTION
IN SUPPORT OF THE MUNICIPAL FUNDING PLAN FOR
THE CHAGRIN VALLEY FIRE DEPARTMENT AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Chagrin Valley Fire Department has been providing regional services to the communities in the Chagrin Valley since 1934; and

WHEREAS, the Chagrin Valley Fire Department has been providing regional services for the past 87 years to the following communities: Chagrin Falls, Bentleyville, Chagrin Falls Township, Hunting Valley, Moreland Hills and South Russell; and

WHEREAS, the communities of the Chagrin Valley served by the Chagrin Valley Fire Department recognize the need for improvements and upgrades to the fire station at a cost of approximately One Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, an ongoing fundraising campaign has raised over Eight Hundred Thousand (\$800,000.00) Dollars of the anticipated One Million Five Hundred Thousand (\$1,500,000.00) Dollar renovation cost; and

WHEREAS, the communities served by the Chagrin Valley Fire Department are committed to participating in the cost of the improvement and upgrades under a cost sharing agreement based on the average squad billing totals to each community for the years 2017, 2018, and 2019; and

WHEREAS, by this non-binding Resolution, the six (6) communities served by the Chagrin Valley Fire Department are committed to a cost sharing agreement which is conditioned upon all six (6) communities reaching consensus on the metrics for distribution of their cost sharing portion and the structure of the escrow account into which their share will be deposited prior to final distribution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:

SECTION 1. That tentative formula based on the annual squad billings (use and run volume) for each community in the Chagrin Valley that the Chagrin Valley Fire Department serves for the years 2017, 2018, and 2019 is as follows:



SECTION 2. That the legislative authority of the Village Council, based on the tentative formula for its average squad billing totals for the years 2017, 2018, and 2019 is, under the terms of this non-binding Resolution authorizing a payment in an amount at or about the sum of One Hundred Fifty-One Thousand Seven Hundred Eighty-Three (\$151,783.00) Dollars, which sum will be contributed to the fund raising campaign escrow account for the improvements and upgrades to the Chagrin Valley Fire Department, said payment to be made on or before December 21, 2022 and memorialized under the terms of a binding Resolution, to be passed by the Village Council.

SECTION 3. The Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the inhabitants of the Village, and for the further reason that due to a need to support the Chagrin Valley Fire Department and its need for improvements and upgrades to the Chagrin Valley Fire Department Fire Station, and to be advised of the non-binding Resolution of the Village at the earliest time possible, so that the Chagrin Valley Fire Department may plan accordingly; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
