

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-60
INTRODUCED BY: DEBERNARDO**

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 951.01
BY LIMITING HOURS ON CONSERVATION LAND AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village Council has determined that hours of use for certain land owned by the Village should only be permitted during daylight hours, for the benefit of law enforcement, neighboring property owners, and the Village as a whole.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. Codified Ordinance Section 951.01 is hereby amended to add a new subsection which reads as follows:

All Conservation Land, and any property located in a Conservation District as defined in the Planning and Zoning Code of the Village of Chagrin Falls and all walking trails located on Public Property may only be used between sunrise and sunset daily and no unauthorized person shall remain on or in any portion of the Conservation Land, any land in a Conservation District after sunset and before sunrise on a daily basis.

SECTION 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 3. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the further reason that enforcement of the hours of use needs to be implemented as soon as possible for the protection of neighboring properties, to reduce the deployment of law enforcement personnel and for the protection of persons utilizing Conservation Land, and any land in a Conservation District; wherefore provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
