**A RESOLUTION  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR A GRANT  
THROUGH THE OHIO OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE  
SERVICES NOT TO EXCEED \$65,000.00 FOR THE  
PURCHASE OF POLICE BODY CAMERAS AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services has been granted funding from the State budget to help outfit law enforcement officers across the state with body cameras; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Chagrin Falls police force body cameras are nearing the end of their useful life and the department has requested that the Village apply for a grant to purchase body cameras and related hardware and software, video storage mechanisms and redacting software/service among other support and fee costs reimbursements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED THERETO CONCURRING:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit applications to the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services to obtain a grant from the 2021 Ohio Body-Camera Grant Program and to execute any and all contracts as may be required for the purposes of obtaining grant funds for such program.

SECTION 2. The Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining a grant from the Ohio Body-Camera Grant Program.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.


SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Resolution shall also be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. This this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason this Resolution is to go into effect immediately to allow

for timely applications to be filed with the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services, since the deadline for applying is October 8, 2021; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
