

**AN ORDINANCE  
AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 129.04(b)(2) OF  
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN  
FALLS TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT FOR POLICE  
DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEE APPLICATIONS TO BE NOTARIZED.**

WHEREAS, Section 129.04(b)(2) of the Codified Ordinances currently requires that all applications for open positions in the police department must be signed by the applicant and notarized;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has determined that notarization of applications for open positions in the police department is no longer necessary;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to reduce the burdens upon applicants for open positions in the police department, in order to assure a full force of officers in the police department.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That existing Subsection (b)(2) of Section 129.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls be and, the same is hereby amended to read and provide in its entirety as follows:

Applications must be signed by the applicant.

SECTION 2. That the existing Subsection (b)(2) of Section 129.04 of the codified ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, and any other ordinance in conflict herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed and reads as follows:

Applications must be signed by the applicant and notarized.

SECTION 3. Codified ordinance section 129.04(b)(2) as amended, shown hereby with underlines for new language and strikeouts for deleted language reads as follows:

Applications must be signed by the applicant ~~and notarized.~~

SECTION 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 5. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


