

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-26**

**AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF PARKING  
PERMITS FOR VILLAGE LEASED PARKING SPACES  
AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION  
THEREOF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, The Village Council has received complaints from Business Owners within the Central Shopping District that employees, business operators and others are parking cars within the Central Shopping District, in the same space, or moving the vehicle to another space within the Central Shopping District for more than three hours, taking away the limited resources of parking available within the Central Shopping District and therefore impairing the intent to preserve the Village's downtown core for retail sales and personal service businesses; and

WHEREAS, the Village has now adopted Ordinance 2019-15 in order to make parking spaces available for customers of businesses within the Central Shopping District by limiting parking within the Central Shopping District to a maximum of three hours, regardless of where the car is parked; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it should issue permits for employee parking for Village leased parking spaces employees and operators of businesses within the Village, which permits will permit parking for the entire business day.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE  
VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The Police Department is hereby authorized to issue permits to employees and operators of businesses located in the Village to permit parking all day, during weekdays, to permit all day parking for such employees and operators of businesses located in the Village, which permits shall be displayed in the front windshield of the vehicle in a prominent place that can be readily observed. The cost of the permit shall be determined by the Village Council after establishment of the permit program. Permits shall be made available for all parking spaces leased by the Village for the purpose of providing parking to employees and operators of businesses located in the Village. The Police Department is hereby directed to install signage at the north, south, east and west boundaries of the Central Shopping District identifying the boundaries of such district, and in the event of any zone map

change to the Central Shopping District to relocate such signage, where necessary, to reflect the revised boundaries. No person shall park a vehicle in a parking space leased by the Village without a permit required by this Section.

SECTION 2. Any person who violates Section 1 of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor and subject to the penalties provided in Codified Ordinance Section 303.99.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance be and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the habitants of the Village and for the reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the permit program can be immediately implemented and to provide for a penalty for those persons who park in Village leased parking spaces without a required permit. Wherefore, provided it receives two-thirds (2/3) of the votes of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


