

**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-50**

**AN ORDINANCE**  
**REPEALING SECTION 549.10 OF THE CODIFIED**  
**ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN**  
**FALLS.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly has made numerous changes to weapons laws and as a result the Village will be amending certain provisions contained in Chapter 549 of the Codified Ordinances;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police for the Village of Chagrin Falls has determined that enforcement of Codified Ordinance Section 549.10 is no longer necessary and should be repealed.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE**  
**VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. Section 549.10 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, the full text of which follows is hereby repealed:

**549.10 Reporting Sale of Firearms.**

(a) No place of business or agent of any place of business shall sell any firearm within the municipality without furnishing in writing to the Chief of Police the name and address of the purchaser of the firearm, the type of gun, the tradename of the firearm and the manufacturer's serial number. Such name, address and other information shall be furnished within 30 days after the sale of the firearm.

(b) Whoever violates this Section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree.

SECTION 2. To the extent Section 549.10 is the subject of an enforcement action, it shall be considered effective for the purposes of enforcement for any violations that occurred prior to repeal.

SECTION 3. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in

compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 4. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 5. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


