**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 149.02(B) OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND REVISING THE
MAINTENANCE AND CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR
POLICE DEPARTMENT MEMBERS.**

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Chargin Falls has determined that the criteria for maintenance and clothing allowance for police employees should be revised for part-time police members:

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. Codified Ordinance Section 149.02(B) the full text which follows is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

(a) Police and Fire Department maintenance and clothing allowances shall, beginning January 1, 2020, read as follows:

Position	Maintenance Allowance per year	Clothing Allowance Per calendar year
Full time police member Employed with the Village for more than 1 year	\$100.00	\$600.00
New police hires (during first year of service)	Pursuant to subsection (e) below.	
Part time police members (working at least 24 hours per week regularly)	\$100.00	\$600.00
Part time police members (working less than 24 hours per week regularly after having served a minimum of 144 hours in the preceeding 12 months, or if they have been working less than a year, at least a miniumum of 12 hours per month for each month in which they have been employed less than a year	\$40.00	\$260.00
Part time police clerk	\$40.00	\$150.00
Full time police clerk	\$70.00	\$380.00
Fire Chief	\$100.00	\$150.00

Full time police clerk	\$70.00	\$380.00
Fire Chief	\$100.00	\$150.00

Part time police members (working less than 32 hours per week regularly after 24 hours per week regularly after having served a minimum of 100 hours excluding Dog Warden and Matrons) <u>(working less than 32 hours per week regularly after having served a minimum of 144 hours in the preceeding 12 months, or if they have been working less than a year, at least a miniumum of 12 hours per month for each month in which they have been employed less than a year having served a minimum of 100 hours excluding Dog Warden and Matrons)</u>	\$40.00	\$260.00
Part time police clerk	\$40.00	\$150.00
Full time police clerk	\$70.00	\$380.00
Fire Chief	\$100.00	\$150.00


