

**ORDINANCE 2020-12  
INTRODUCED BY: MR. ROCKEY**

**AN ORDINANCE  
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN  
AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF SAFETY,  
BUREAU OF MOTOR VEHICLES (“BMV”) FOR THE  
PROVISION AND USE OF INFORMATION REGARDING  
VEHICLE REGISTRATION RECORDS AND RELATED  
MATTERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Police Department for the Village of Chagrin Falls has requested that the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Motor Vehicles (“BMV”) provide vehicle registration records and related information in order for the Police Department to operate the software systems for enforcement of parking regulations in the Village of Chagrin Falls; and

WHEREAS, the BMV has required that the Village enter into an Agreement for the provision and use of such information; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to enter into the Agreement with BMV in order for the Police Department to receive vehicle registration records and related information.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION 1. That the Mayor be and hereby is authorized and directed to enter into an Agreement with BMV for the purpose of obtaining vehicle registration records and related information in accordance with the Agreement for the provision and use of such information attached hereto and made a part hereof as **EXHIBIT “A”**. The Mayor, the Chief of Police and Lisa Mariola, Administrative Assistant in the Police Department, may execute such further documentation and perform such additional actions as may be necessary to accomplish the purposes of the Agreement including, but not limited to, the delivery of BMV Forms 1173, 3343 and 3110.

SECTION 2. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 3. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health and safety of the habitants of the Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the Village Police Department may be able to obtain vehicle registration records and related information to enforce the parking Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


