

**ORDINANCE 2020-13

**AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE BID OF
S.E.T., INC. OF LOWELLVILLE FOR THE EAST
WASHINGTON STREET SEWER REHABILITATION (SSO
ELIMINATION (INFLOW & INFILTRATION) AND EAST
WASHINGTON STREET WATERLINE REPLACEMENT
PROJECT, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT WITH S.E.T., INC. TO PERFORM THE
EAST WASHINGTON STREET SEWER REHABILITATION
AND EAST WASHINGTON WATERLINE PROJECT, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Village of Chagrin Falls is required to take steps to eliminate inflow and infiltration of stormwater in the sanitary sewers of the Village and it is determined that it is necessary to repair and/or replace certain waterlines on East Washington Street (collectively “the Project”);

WHEREAS, the Village has now received bids for the Project and the Village has determined the best and most responsible bid received was from S.E.T., Inc. (“SET”) and the Village therefore desires to enter into an agreement with SET to perform the Project as soon as possible.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1. The bid of SET for Part A of the Project, the SSO Elimination (Inflow & Infiltration) Project in the amount of \$2,440,274.02 be accepted, being the lowest and best bid for said improvement as set forth in the specification of the Village.

Section 2. The bid of SET for Part B of the Project, the East Washington Street Waterline Replacement Project in the amount of \$591,734.00 be accepted, being the lowest and best bid for said improvement as set forth in the specification of the Village.

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Section 3. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with SET for the East Washington Street Sewer Rehabilitation which includes Part A, the SSO Elimination (Inflow & Infiltration) and Part B, the East Washington Street Waterline Replacement, as stated about in the total amount of \$3,032,008.02 as specified in the contract attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit "A"**.

Section 4. The Finance Director is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 3 of this Ordinance.

Section 5. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

Section 6. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance needs to take immediate effect as it is necessary to authorize the Project to be immediately performed in order to comply with the Village's obligation to reduce SSO Elimination, and to replace waterlines in accordance with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency funding requirements; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.


