

**ORDINANCE 2020-19**  
**INTRODUCED BY: GRUBE**

**AN ORDINANCE**  
**AFFIRMING FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE**  
**CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND WILL BE EXPENDED**  
**ONLY TO COVER COSTS OF THE VILLAGE CONSISTENT**  
**WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 5001 OF THE**  
**CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC**  
**SECURITY ACT AS DESCRIBED IN 42 U.S.C. 601(d), AND**  
**ANY APPLICABLE REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN**  
**EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Ohio Senate has passed Amended Senate Bill No. 310 (“SB310”) and the Bill awaits passage in the Ohio House;

WHEREAS, SB 310, or any other nomenclature for legislation to be adopted by the 133<sup>rd</sup> General Assembly for distribution of funds granted to the State of Ohio for distribution to local governments and authorizes distribution of funds from the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (“CARES”) which will be deposited into a fund in the Cuyahoga County Treasury, or any other distribution made by the State directly to the Village of Chagrin Falls may require the Village to affirm the funds so received may be expended only to cover costs of the Village consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of CARES, as described in 42 U.S. C. 601(d) and any applicable regulations;

WHEREAS, in the event and to the extent that such legislation is adopted by the Ohio General Assembly, the Village has determined to express its affirmance that any funds so received will only be expended to cover costs consist with the requirements of Section 5001 of CARES, as described in 42 U.S. C. 601(d);

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE**  
**OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1. The Village of Chagrin Falls hereby affirms that any funds received from the State of Ohio or Cuyahoga County pursuant to CARES to provide for coronavirus relief, will only be expended to cover costs of the Village consistent with the requirements of Section 5001 of CARES, as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d) and any applicable regulations.

Section 2. The Village hereby requests that the State of Ohio and/or Cuyahoga County disburse to the Village its share of the money from the Coronavirus Relief Distribution Fund as soon as possible in order to assist the Village in responding to the Corona virus that has negatively impacted the Village of Chagrin Falls.

Section 3. The Clerk of Council shall certify a copy of this Ordinance to the Cuyahoga County Auditor and the Ohio Director of Budget and Management upon adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Upon receipt of any money authorized by any legislation adopted by the State of Ohio authorizing distribution of Coronavirus Relief Funds to the Village shall be deposited into a new fund in the Village's Treasury to be named the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund by the Village's Fiscal Officer and the funds shall be used only for the purposes permitted by Section 5001 of CARES as described in 42 U.S.C. 601(d).

Section 5. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

Section 6. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

Section 7. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that the Village can receive a distribution of the Coronavirus Relief Fund upon the earliest date possible to assist the Village in combating the Corona Virus; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
