AN ORDINANCE
CREATING A NO STOPPING OR PARKING ZONE ON
BELL STREET DURING THE EAST WASHINGTON
STREET CONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village will be engaging in a substantial construction project on East Washington Street that will commence July 6, 2020 and may not be concluded until December of 2020, and as a result of such construction project, vehicular traffic on East Washington Street will be closed and a detour route will be on Bell Street.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Chief Administrative Officer have determined that the roadway width and curves on Bell Street would create an unsafe situation for stopped or parked vehicles on a portion of Bell Street and therefore it is necessary to create a no stopping or parking zone on a portion of Bell Street during the East Washington Street construction project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE
OF CHAGRIN FALLS, CUYAHOGA COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. Commencing on July 13, 2020 and ending upon the conclusion of the East Washington Street project, no vehicles, as defined in Codified Ordinance Section 301.51 shall stop or park on any traveled portion of Bell Street from the west boundary of Philomethian Street and the east boundary of Ridgewood Road between the hours of 7:00 a.m. through 10:00 a.m. and from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., except in the case of an undue hardship, and with prior notice to and written approval from the Chief of Police, a delivery vehicle that cannot park in a driveway, if the weight load being carried for the delivery or service could cause damage to the driveway, then stopping may be permitted for such period of time as the Chief of Police determines is necessary for the delivery or service visit

Section 2. The no stopping or parking order shall include a prohibition against delivery vehicles, contractors, landscapers, or similar vehicles from stopping or parking on the portion of Bell Street designated in Section 1 of this Ordinance during the hours and days designated in Section 1 of this Ordinance except when written approval is obtained from the Chief of Police as provided in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any police officer shall have the authority to order or direct any person operating a vehicle in violation of this Ordinance to immediately move their vehicle from the

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
prohibited stopping or parking areas of Bell Street as set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance and any person violating such lawful order or direction shall be deemed to be in violation of Codified Ordinance Section 303.01. Whoever is convicted of or pleads guilty to a violation of this Ordinance is guilty of a minor misdemeanor upon the first conviction and any subsequent conviction for violating this Ordinance is guilty of a third degree misdemeanor.

Section 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

Section 5. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Ordinance shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

Section 6. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective since the East Washington Street construction project commenced on July 6, 2020, prior to the adoption of this Ordinance and for the further reason that this Ordinance must be immediately effective so that Bell Street is used in a safe manner; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force after the earliest period allowed by law.
