A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO TEMPORARILY AMEND THE TRAFFIC CONTROL MAP ON MAY COURT AND ELM COURT TO BAN MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING FOR A PERIOD OF THIRTY (30) DAYS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Chagrin Falls has determined that business employee parking has caused potential safety issues on May Court and Elm Court in the Village of Chagrin Falls and prior attempts to obtain voluntary compliance by such employees to park in lots designated by the Village, at Village cost, has been unsuccessful; and

WHEREAS, the residents of May Court have requested the Village consider parking bans and prohibit parking on May Court and Elm Court at certain times, in order to provide for safe travel by school buses, public safety and service vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the 2018-2019 school year is about to commence and the Village has determined that some immediate action is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAGRIN FALLS, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA, AND STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the Traffic Control Map, for a period of thirty (30) days, be amended to prohibit parking of motor vehicles on all of May Court on both sides of the street, and on both sides of Elm Court from its intersection with May Court to its intersection with Village Circle from 7:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M. from Monday through Saturday.

SECTION 2. That the Chief of Police, upon the effective date of this Resolution, install and post no parking signs providing for the times and days when parking is prohibited, on both sides of the street on May Court and Elm Court between May Court and Village Circle. The Police Department is hereby directed to temporarily amend the Traffic Control Map in accordance with this Resolution, and to enforce parking in accordance with the Traffic Control Map, as temporarily amended by this Resolution from and after the effective date of this Resolution.

SECTION 3. That the Chief of Police and the Streets and Safety Committee consider a permanent solution to parking and safety issues and report back to the Village Council before the thirty (30) day parking ban lapses.

SECTION 4. That actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this legislation were adopted in lawful meetings of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 114 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls.

SECTION 5. That in accordance with Section 113.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Chagrin Falls, public notice of this Resolution shall be given by posting a copy thereof for not less than fifteen (15) days in the Village Hall.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon the earliest date allowed by law.
